Terms & Conditions

Rules – All classes to be ran in accordance with British Showjumping & Pony Club 2023/2024 Rulebook.

All rounds will be ran as single phase (riders to jump both parts, unless eliminated, second part timed, faults to be accumulated) under BS rules, with the provision of three refusals will result in elimination as opposed to two.

Competitors will be able to walk the course at the beginning of each class or at the allocated times only.

Timings – All timings are approximate and it is the competitors responsibility to ensure they are ready to jump . Declaration in the collection ring must be made with a minimum of 10 minutes before jumping time

Objections – All objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 5 minutes of conclusion of the relevant class with a £30 deposit. Videos and photo evidence will not be admissible.

Ages– All ages as of 1st January 2024

Medics – Will be in attendance

Team Scores – Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 riders from the same club. Best 3 scores will count. (All members will also count as individuals)

Team Entries – Team Managers will be emailed for Teams after entries closed. To be submitted by Wednesday 24th September

Photography – Please note professional photographers will be in attendance. Please contact the secretary if you do not wish your photo to be taken

Refreshments – Will be available onsite

Conditions of Entry – The judges decision is final. Entry fees cannot be refunded without a doctors or a veterinary note. In any event a £5 fee per class will be retained to cover administration costs

Responsibility – All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf. All competitors and those associated with their Pony Club are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition. All enquiries are to be made by the Team Manager please. The organisers will not be liable for any claims in respect of damage, loss or injury to any person, whether spectator or competitor, horse or property however caused, in connection with or arising out of the competition.

General Rules

- Do not muck out horsebox into the car park. Please keep areas clean and tidy
- All litter to be taken home with you
- Dogs must be kept on lead at all times and cleared up after
- Outside assistance will not be tolerated (In Unassisted classes) and could occur elimination
- All competitors, representatives and parents must act responsibly and and courteously towards all stewards and officials. Rudeness will not be tolerated.
- Only the team manager for each club is to deal with the show secretary for declarations, enquires and objections
- The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor whos riding helmet is not fastened when riding .
- Hats must be to the correct Pony Club 2024 standards
- Hair must be secured and hairnets strongly recommended
- Body protectors recommended
- The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and they must obey the instructions of the organisers, stewards and officials.
- All damages must be paid for
- All entries must be covered with the correct fee
- Vehicles, boxes and trailer are parked entirely at owners own risk
- Horses and/or ponies tied outside to the box/trailer must not be left unattended
- All competitors to provide their own arena party
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, in which case, entry fees will be refunded (Less £5 per competitor)
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving reason
- Non Pony Club competitors are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. Bedfordshire South Branch of the Pony Club and its organisers are not legally responsible for non members and their insurance will not cover you.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions the competition will be rescheduled
- Anyone entering this competition will be deemed to have agreed to abide by the rules in this schedule and Pony Club rules.
